Purposes and Legal Basis for Processing

- Third-party service providers for IT, analytics, marketing, and security purposes
- Regulatory authorities when legally required

International Data Transfers

- Transfers outside the EU/UK will follow appropriate safeguards (where applicable and necessary), such as:
 - Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs)
 - Adequacy decisions
 - Binding Corporate Rules (BCRs)

Data Retention Period

- Retained for as long as necessary to fulfil processing purposes
- Logs retained for security purposes for one (1) year
- Data retained for legal defence for a defined statutory period
